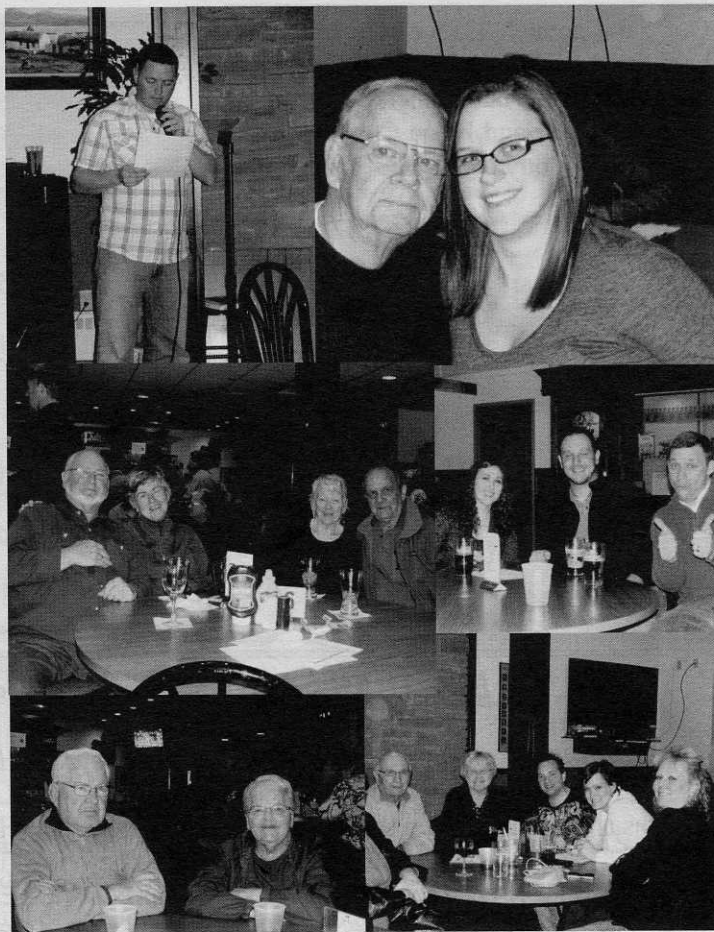
The winning team takes 50% of the profit and the other half of the money goes to St. Pat's Gaelic Football Team, the WSIA's resident team.

## 2011 REPORT FROM YOUR TRUSTEES

Our recent addition of the Madison/Abbey rooms, which were completed in December 2010, is turning out to be a definite asset. Rentals are bring in new people who see our club for the first time. This in turn is increasing new memberships, renewals and additional rentals. **The addition is fully paid for.**

This past year we had a slight increase in membership renewals and new members which is encouraging. Any help in securing new members would be appreciated.

Our immediate improvement will be the addition of restrooms to our pavilion. It's is expected they will be available this coming summer.

### IMPROVEMENTS IN THE PLANNING/TALKING STAGES INCLUDE:

- ◆ *Updating our main entrance to include covered pickup/drop-off, lighting, landscaping, etc. Estimated cost \$95,000.00*
- ◆ *Resurface our parking lot and driveways which need attention from over twenty years of use. Estimated cost \$138,000.00 to \$140,000.00.*
- ◆ *Additional parking in closer proximity to our new rooms/pub area. Estimated cost \$18,000.00 to \$24,000.00*
- ◆ *Extend the use of our pavilion into the April/May—October/November months by enclosing it. Estimated cost \$16,000.00.*

These improvements and others will be addressed as finances become available. Expenditures in 2010-11 ate up just about all of our cash in hand. We are steadily rebuilding our treasury.

The continued support of all our members is appreciated. Indeed, it is vital if we are to carry out the necessary maintenance and improvements of our facilities.
