

Ben Clingain - Family man, business man and musician

From his humble beginnings in Derry to his semi-retirement in Cleveland, Ben led a varied and hard working life. He was brought up by his adored mum and two sisters, and spent his childhood being educated by the Christian Brothers. He later attended Queen's University Belfast, where he studied, amongst other subjects, Latin! After his mother and sisters emigrated to New York he travelled around England, working on farms and as a bus conductor before following his family to the USA. He returned to England in 1970 and settled into married life. He started his own newspaper, which expanded into a small empire of newspapers and magazines in the late 1970s and early 80s. He had a great passion for soccer. He loved Manchester United and he played for local teams and also coached junior teams. He also published many books including books about golf and hunting. He returned to Cleveland in 2000 to settle near to his elder sisters, who so lovingly gave him so much as a young boy. In Cleveland, he found the time to pursue his passion for music. He played many gigs with "Bald Paul's Irish Blues Band" bringing joy to the residents of Cleveland's bars, clubs and nursing homes up until he died tragically in June, 2011. He left behind his sister Sarah; four devoted children: Elisabeth, Neil, Thomas and Emily; four grandchildren: Danielle, Mason, Oliver and Ruby; and two nieces: Siobhan and Tara.




