

ROSE OF TRALEE

The Rose of Tralee International Festival is one of Ireland's largest and longest running festivals, celebrating 57 years in 2016. The heart of the festival is the selection of the Rose of Tralee which brings young women of Irish descent from around the world to County Kerry, Ireland for a global celebration of Irish culture. The festival also includes street entertainment, carnival, live concerts, theatre, circus, markets, fun fair, fireworks and the internationally renowned Rose Parade.

Qualities of a Rose

The qualities of a Rose are defined by the words of the song <u>The Rose of Tralee</u> and crystallized by the young woman who is chosen as the Rose of Tralee at the International Festival.

Over the years, Roses have mirrored a changing Ireland and the definition of "Irishness" that is celebrated by so many different people around the world. A Rose represents the collective aspirations, social responsibilities and ambitions of a variety of communities and backgrounds united by a desire to celebrate Irish heritage in a positive and refreshing way.


