WORD HAS IT....

From Your Library

"In The Company of Others" by Jan Karon; review by Rose Conley: Many are fans of the Mitford Series of books by Karon. In this publication, Father Kavanagh and his wife are in County Sligo, Ireland, where Fr. Tim hopes to introduce Cynthia to his ancestral homeland. The good Father becomes enthralled with the history of Cathamore, a 19th Century Estate filled with history. Karon takes us between the past and the present through the Kavanagh's reading of an old journal they find. You might find yourself a bit discombobulated with all the names, very old Gaelic names. This is definitely an Irish story, probably more understandable by native Irish people, rather than we Americans. Although this is another very fine Jan Karon book, it isn't the same as reading the warm, comfy Mitford books with all the characters for which we are so comfortable. Fr. Tim still involves himself in the surroundings and the people, helping to understand and solve their problems. The author's characterizations are portrayed the same fine way of making us feel we know the people and want to revisit with them. Check out the book in the McNeeley Library and follow Fr. Tim on a new chapter of his life.


