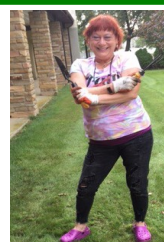

GARDEN NEWS

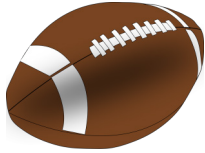
It's hard to believe, but another season of gardening is over, and it's time to get ready for OLD MAN WINTER!!!! We had a good year, and I have lots of people to thank.
