

FRIDAY NIGHT PUB GRUB NEWS

Thanks to everyone for supporting the Friday night venues at the club. It has been quite an adventure since the change in our lives due to the covid virus. Gunselman's Tavern had undertaken Fridays 2 years ago in the summer, but was stopped in March of 2020 due to Governor DeWine's order to stop restaurants from serving in house. At that time the club had no revenue since all gatherings were cancelled due to the virus.

I decided to try to raise some revenue by starting to go meals on Fridays with a limited group of wonderful volunteers and we were somewhat successful until a few weeks later when the governor lifted the ban on in house dining and we opened with Helen Malloy's entertainment on Fridays again.
