**WORD HAS IT.....
From Your McNeeley Library**

Book Review by Kay Martin. Kay submitted a brief review on two books recently; I consequently choose to present both to you at this time.

***The Daughters of Erietown* by Connie Schult.** (Ms. Schultz is the wife of Congressman Sherrod Brown). The story takes place in Clayton, Ohio. Ellie is an extremely bright young girl dreaming of going to nursing school. Brick is a basketball star. He plans to go to college and he would be the first of his blue-collar family to do so. It would also give him a way to escape his abusive father. Ellie's unexpected pregnancy changes all of that. This is a story of a working-class family, their cultural, their sacrifices, secrets, and about women shaping their family history.

***The Giver of Stars* by JoJo Moyes.** This is based on a true story during the time of America's great depression. Five strong, determined women answer the request of Eleanor Roosevelt for a traveling library in the hills of Kentucky. They become known as the "Packhorse Librarians of Kentucky". Margery is the leader, strong, depends only on herself, wants nothing from a man. Alice lives a stifling life in England, marries her American husband and settles in a small town in Kentucky. They are joined by three other independent women. These packhorse librarians deliver library books to the people living in the hills and hollows; people who have never had books, people who can read and become educated to change their lives. The women endure a brutal, but beautiful landscape, full of dangers and challenges.


