Midwest Fest – Gaelic Games, the Achill Visit, Pipe Bands, and Trad Music go leor

Cleveland St. Pat's – St. Jarlath's Gaelic Athletic Association (GAA) will be hosting the Midwest Finals at Barton Bradley Field in North Olmsted over the August 5th and 6th weekend. The Club hosted at the WSIA back in 2017, but the divisional competition has outgrown the facilities. Teams from around the Midwest – including Cincinnati, Detroit, Akron, Pittsburgh, Buffalo, Rochester, Syracuse, and Albany will compete in Gaelic football, hurling, and camogie. With the Finals being a junior level competition, Cleveland has invited Achill GAA (*Cumann Lúthchleas Gael Acla*) to play a showcase game on Saturday against the Pittsburgh Celtics (an Intermediate level team that was formally senior level). With the invitation, our twinning counterparts in Achill will be arriving in town on Wednesday August 2nd, late in the evening. On Thursday, August 3rd, the Achillites will enjoy some site seeing in town, then will join Cleveland's men's team at the WSIA at 6PM for a joint training session. The latter half of the training session is planned to be a friendly scrimmage between the teams ending around 7:30pm. The teams will combine in the pub for a social and welcome from the WSIA. All are free to come up to the Club for the scrimmage and afters.

Making the Irish visit possible is Michael Martin McNulty while Brian Holleran is heading up the traditional musicians who are traveling in from all Across North America. Joining CLG Acla on the trip over will be several members of the island's pipe bands. Throughout the sporting activities the pipe bands and trad-heads will be playing away.

Friday the visitors will be off again during the day, but all are invited back to PJ McIntyre's on Friday evening for the Midwest Finals Welcoming and a GAA Commemoration of the Twinning of Achill and Cleveland. The event will start at 7PM, with brief welcoming speeches at 8PM, and a prize draw at 9PM (ask around for the lottery tickets and the prize amount !!!).

Saturday the games begin in earnest starting at 9:30 at Barton Bradley Fields (North Olmsted). The weekend is being billed as "Midwest Fest – Midwest GAA Championships – Gaelic Football, Hurling, and Camogie plus pipe bands, traditional music, food trucks, beverage trucks, and youth clinics and games. and These are quarter-final and semi-finals matches". The Midwest Division is working through the final details of the schedule, but the Cleveland Saints will have five teams competing for you to root-on. Besides the games, the pipe bands will be playing, traditional music sessions from the finest players in North America will be in some of the tents, the youth will have free clinics on football and hurling followed by games (new players welcome), pints will flow, and stories will be shared. Come 5PM, the youth players and pipe band will join with the CLG Acla and Pittsburgh Celtics GFC to parade the field before the showcase match. After the game, the music will continue until about 8PM when the socializing will continue at PJ McIntyre's.

Sunday will be the highlight junior games as all the divisional finals will be played. The pipe bands will once again be on hand and the Midwest will present trophies to the champions of each code. The final showcase match of the day will see the Pittsburgh Pucas (junior national champions last year) take-on the Midwest All-Stars, a combination of top players from around the division and a few of the braver CLG Acla members. Sunday evening may be the most important event for the GAA community that stretches from Cleveland to Achill as the clubs and their supporters (including you) will be back at the WSIA for a dinner and planning session – how do we improve ties between our communities, how do we get the young folks exchanged and connected to each other, how do we do this sooner than another 40 years, will Cleveland make the return trip in 2024 – *le cúnamh Dé*.

Most of the Achillites will depart Monday. For more details on the schedule, tickets, and volunteer opportunities please visit clevelandGAA.com, email clevelandGAA@gmail.com, or call Vincent at 216-209-5845. After the Midwest Finals weekend, Cleveland will be sending the men's Gaelic, hurling, and camogies teams on to Denver for the national championships.

Thank you for all the support and foundation of culture that makes an event like this possible. We hope to see you out there and we welcome all who want to be part of it.




