Book Review: *"We Don't Know Ourselves: A Personal History of Modern Ireland"* Author: Fintan O'Toole. Review provided by Donna Gilson.

This is a history of Ireland beginning in 1959, the year of the author's birth, from his perspective. He uses many historical events to tell the story of Ireland and his personal story, i.e., the Irish Army in the Congo in 1961. He writes of joining the EU in 1973, the hunger strikes of 1981, the Good Friday Agreement of 1998 and the grandiose delusions of the Celtic tiger in 2008. O'Toole highlights how Ireland was able to emerge from the shadows to become a world class global economy and the cultural ramifications such as divorce, gay marriage and abortion. Some of his telling phrases were: "Being European was the ultimate way of not being British"; "The idea of disappearance hung over the place"; "The violence was strangely weightless"; "There was nothing as simple or as stable as mere hypocrisy"; "The Irish economy was most like Humpty Dumpty – bloated, fragile sitting smugly at great height and headed for a fall".

Fintan O'Toole is an *Irish Times* journalist, well known as a reporter and commentator. "Tracking the story of modern Ireland by pinning important cultural moments to personal events in his life allows O'Toole to humanize and particularize complex historical realities. . . O'Toole makes this book both deeply personal and rigorously objective at the same time." Michael Pearson, New York Journal of Books.

This is a personal history of six decades of Irish life from someone who understands it from the historic, economic and cultural perspective, It is powerful, it is compassionate and it is also critical.






