

**WORD HAS IT.....
From Your Library**

Book review by Rose Conley. *“The Pilot’s Wife* by Anita Shreve.

This isn’t a woman’s book only, men can relate to the strong story and subject. This is a story of love, devotion and betrayal of one person in a marriage. Who can guess what a woman will do and say when the unthinkable becomes the reality of her life. Jack and Kathryn Lyons have been married 16 years, have one teenage daughter, Maddie, living on the coast of New England. Jack is piloting an international airliner when suddenly the flight disappears from radar near the coast of Ireland. Kathryn’s journey begins after the dreaded knock on the door. Kathryn answers the door to the officials who have come to tell her the plane crashed with no survivors. Her ordeal begins from that point. There are news stories, people interviewing her, suspicion of a bomb on board the plane. All this as she grieves and tries to comfort her 15-year-old daughter who was so close with her father. Kathryn sets out to find out what happened on the flight, to get answers to so many questions. She goes to Ireland where so much is revealed. She begins to think her husband may have been leading a double life. She questions how well she knew her husband. She questions his loyalty to her, their daughter, his country. She is perplexed when learning of her husband’s involvement pertaining to the conflict in Northern Ireland. As Kathryn moves through this process, events unfold to lay open the guarded secret her husband kept hidden from her all those years. Now she finds herself reevaluating everything about their life together. She reviews events, memories and feelings, trying to discover the signs and symptoms of the beginning of betrayal and the end of trust.

Note from reviewer: This book was published in 1998, a time when Northern Ireland was experiencing difficulties.


