

**WORD HAS IT.....  
From Your Library**

Sharing a delightful story from a long time member of our IA Club on Madison Avenue; submitted by Helen Malloy: It was March 17, 1959, Pat Lynch was president of the club. Members had met the day before, Mar. 16<sup>th</sup>, and made 300 ham sandwiches. Mr. Lynch always made sure we had bread from a local Italian Bakery and he provided top brand hams. Back in that time many club members came to our facility on Madison Avenue on St. Patrick's morning to start their festivities. It was our tradition for all our marching groups to gather ready to march from Madison Avenue to St. Colman's Church at W. 65<sup>th</sup> St. and Detroit Road for the mass; after which we would board buses paid for by the Club, which took us downtown to participate in the parade. We then were brought back to the club on the buses to enjoy the rest of the day with our fellow members and families.

This day in 1959 I was a member of the Ladies Drill Team, wearing the required white shoes and stockings. It was wet, snowy, lots of slush but true to our Irish heritage, all the groups gathered for the march to St. Colman's. After the mass we gathered to go downtown, at which time Pat Lynch informed us the parade had been cancelled. He had that information all along, but he obviously considered the ritual of the march very necessary for the day. I don't remember how we got back to the Club, we didn't march, but he must have made arrangements for us some way. We all returned to the Club and celebrated St. Patrick's Day.




