NEW ARRIVAL: McNeeley Library has just received two new editions of "**HEROIC MAYO**" by Michael Feeney. We sincerely thank Mr. Thomas Jordon for his very generous donation of the books which we received from Mcloughlin's Bookstore in Westport. They were published December 2023.

Mr. Feeney has written a well researched, detailed book with an abundance of photos of Mayo Heroes, Irish men and women who served and died in the world wars, other overseas wars and on United Nations peace-keeping operations.

This reviewer did not read the entire 522-page book, but in my overall review I recognized so many names and can't help but wonder how many club members will find the story of their relatives in this book. 




The Club Float Committee is looking for an artist to assist with float design and artistic help with upcoming floats for the St. Patrick's Day Parade.




