WORD HAS IT.... From Your Library

The Briar Club, Kate Quinn author: review by Rose Conley. This is a thought-provoking novel about friendship in Washington, DC during the McCarthy era. The Briarwood House, circa 1950, is an all-female boardinghouse in Washington, D.C. The ladies staying at the house come from different backgrounds. Floss is English and a wife and mother. Nora whose gangster boyfriend could prove troublesome as her father is a police officer. Bea is a fascinating woman who used to be part of the women's baseball league. Arlene is political motivated. Grace March, the latest arrival, lives in the attic. She has become the popular one attracting the people with her dinner parties. Mrs. Nillson, the mother of two children, Pete and Lena, is the landlady in charge.

This story takes place after WWII in a boarding house. You become familiar with all the characters as Ms. Quinn delves into their lives in individual chapters. Slowly, the relationships begin to fit together. Each of the residents have a different background and their stories form a piece of history happening in the 1950's. I didn't necessarily like all of the ladies, but all were strong women in their own way. When two murders occur, tearing the ladies apart, they learn the value of standing by one another. It is not until the ending of the story that all comes together; that the value of their friendships proves true.

For those of you who are into cooking, you will appreciate the recipes. It brought to mind for me, that period when I was coming into realization of the intent interest my parents had in the news. It was surprising the degree to which McCarthy created unrest in the US post WII. It was a highly political period when McCarthyism was a word heard daily in the news and headlines, along with racism, the "Red Threat" and the cold war.




