## **Céide Fields**


This writer just returned from Ireland. Although I have visited multiple times, none touched me as this trip has. I was privileged to view up close, history as I never imagined. We traveled to North County Mayo to visit Céide Fields. The Céide Fields is an archaeological site on the north County Mayo coast in the west of Ireland, near Ballycastle.

This began in 1930's when a local schoolteacher, Patrick Caulfield from Belderrig, noticed piles of stones in the bottom of the bog as he was cutting turf. Unbelievably nothing came of it until forty years later his son, Seamus, completed his education to become an archaeologist. He began studying the stones his father had uncovered in the bog. He realized what it all meant and went on with other investigators to reveal the remains of a Stone Age landscape of stone walled fields, houses and megalithic tombs over 5000 years old, all preserved and concealed by the growth of blanket bogs over the course of many centuries. Think of it, our ancestors of 200 generations ago lived, worked, raised families and it was all hidden for centuries.

The Visitor's Center at The Fields has portrayed the growth of this history beautifully for our education. Many interesting displays, including the pictured bog pine tree, part of an ancient forest of pine trees. The tree has been radiocarbon dated to 4300 years old. You can walk out onto the fields and be a part of all of it. You can actually try to unearth another part of the past. Céide Fields overlooks the mighty Atlantic Ocean. The waves pound furiously against the cliffs, winds try to blow you far across the fields.

My daughter and son-in-law were awestruck. There are numerous digs in the area where they live in Arizona but nothing like The Fields. Kelly Short had this to say; "It's an experience that leaves you with a deep appreciation for the resilience of our ancestors, set in a beautiful and remote location. # The Old Club on Madison Ave

It still looks the same, two-story yellow brick building with the main entrance doors that are level with the sidewalk. Inside, the ticket booth window was on the right and the cloak room was on the left. The restrooms were in the east/west corners behind them.

When you entered the main hall which was half the size of our present hall, it was like stepping into cheerful chaos; the band was playing and everyone was talking and laughing. You did not need a name there, everyone knew who you were or they knew your family. Both walls had built-in wooden benches that ran the length of the hall and the Grannies and non-drinkers usually sat on them and greeted other members. Warm and friendly, they always asked "What's new?" and "How's your mother?" Always a great welcome.

This generation that came to Cleveland in the 30's and 40's gave us the first foundation of the club. They brought Ireland to us with warmth, the traditions, stories, music, ethics, manners and a wonderful outlook on life. They loved America and loved the WSIA and seeing their friends from the old country. People from Ireland were called "Greenhorns" and their children were called "Narrowbacks". In those days the labels helped identify members with the same name, like John Gallagher, Pat O'Malley, Mary Kilbane, Mary Malloy and all the Bridgies, Paddy's and Mikes. No disrespect was associated with them and I liked being a "Narrowback" even if I wasn't sure of it's true meaning.

The young moms took their places on the benches on Sunday afternoons during the St. Patrick's Day parade preparation. The musicians practiced in the upstairs rooms, Don't ask where the Dads were.

Murals of Ireland decorated the walls. They were painted by the late Tom Campbell who spent hours creating them. We were also blessed with his incredible talent in our new club. Thank you Tom and may you rest in peace. The Campbell family has carried on with the WSIA float in the parade and took first place many times. Next year they will honor Saint Bridget.

The raised stage was on the back wall and two bands alternated thru the night, an Irish band and an American Band. The Irish band played Sets, Reels and Waltzes, and the Yank band played Jitterbug and soft slow dances. It worked out very well and most of the crowd danced to both.

The dance floor was one of the best in the Midwest and it had a mirrored revolving ball centered in the middle of it and it was marvelous. The shimmering from it created a fairy land and many romances had their beginnings under it. I wonder how many of us owe our very existence to a first dance there? It was later known as a Disco Ball, but we had it first in the fifties. If it was a fundraiser, concert or holiday celebration, small round tables were set up on the back part of the main room. Hot dishes were not on the menu, just sandwiches, pastries, loads of soda bread and of course strong Irish Tea. The doorway to the pub was left of the dance floor and it was policed by a man that was the epitome of dedication to the club, Pat Lynch. He was a real gentleman, always fair, but always feared. He ran the Bar room like a Maitre d' at an expensive restaurant. Everyone was expected to act like ladies and gentlemen and kids were not allowed in the pub. He never married and we were all his children. He went back to Ireland and died in 1971, when the club in Olmsted Twp. was just a fleeting dream. If only he could see us now.


