### **Book Review: *The Ladies' Midnight Swimming Club* by Faith Hogan**

This heartwarming story is just the right fit for a cold snowy winter in Ohio. The story takes place on Ireland's wild Atlantic Coast in a small fishing village, Ballycove, County Mayo. The book is not in the McNeeley Library at this time, check your local library.

The story evolves around five characters: Elizabeth, whose physician husband has died and left her with his gambling debts and no way to save their home. Jo, close friend of Elizabeth, who loves to spend time in the ocean at night and is keeping a serious secret from everyone. She brings delightful humor and wisdom to the story. Lucy, a physician, the daughter of Jo, who needs a break from her busy emergency room job in Dublin and time to help her son heal from the divorce. There is Lucy's teenage son Niall, who has no desire to leave his Dublin life to live in a fishing village; maybe he should live with his Dad in Australia. Dan is a writer who needs a sabbatical to regenerate after an unfortunate event related to his latest screenplay. He comes to the village to write a novel and in search of his birth mother. The story touches briefly on the disgraceful time of the horrible institutions run by catholic nuns with regard to unmarried mothers in Ireland. In reality, the strength of women when faced with illness, death and adversity.

During a short five-month time we spend with the people in Ballycove, we encounter the fallout of infidelity and a loveless marriage, the bond of family and friendships, the importance of making the right decisions, the closeness of community, and the beauty of strength of character.






