WORD HAS IT..... From Your Library

Book Review: *The Irishman: I Heard You Paint Houses* by Charles Brandt; review by Rose Conley

The author of this book does not write sensational accounts, nor does he write from conjecture or theory in this or his other works. The author did his homework and conducted a series of highly detailed interviews with a man who knew how to kill, and did so when called upon by his bosses to do so. This is not a novel, this is a historical and factual investigation which kept this reader turning pages. Author Charles Brandt, former Chief Deputy Attorney General of Delaware, spent years interviewing Frank Sheeran regarding his alleged involvement in Jimmy Hoffa's disappearance. The last of the interviews were conducted in the assisted living facility where Frank Sheeran lived his final years. He died at 83 years of age.

Frank Sheeran was born in 1920 in Darby, Pa. This Irish-Catholic family was poor. His father was not a good influence on his children. Frank, who from youth was a big boy, stood 6'4" tall as a man. His father took him to farms where they could steal vegetables for the family meal. He taught him how to fight at a very young age, then would enter bars, bet a quarter that the 10-year-old Frank could whip the 15-year-old son of any customer. If Frank lost, his head would get the cuff of his father's hand. As he grew older during the depression, he drifted around doing carnival work, received sex lessons from carnival dancers, worked as a logger and was a very talented dance instructor, finally ending up in August 1941 at 20 years of age in the U.S. Army during World War II. He spent 411 days in combat in which he learned to kill the enemy and especially the captured enemy. He participated in the massacre of more than 500 German army prisoners of war at Dachau. Later Sheeran said "I had tightened up inside and I never loosened up again. You get used to death. You get used to killing"

The book goes into Sheeran's life after the army, all of which involved dishonesty and unsavory jobs. It covers his two marriages, his daughters and his association with the Teamsters Union. He became involved with Hoffa and they became close friends. He admired Hoffa who introduced him to Russell Bufalino, the Pennsylvania godfather. He soon became the one who "painted houses", he was the hit man. You will read in this book not only stories about the union in that mid-1930's time, but there is also detail information regarding the Dallas shooting of President Kennedy, and later Bobby Kennedy. Sheeran was involved, but did not kill either of them. This is a chilling book, written extremely well, researched thoroughly, a part of history America cannot brag about. You can find the book in your local library and in audible form as well.

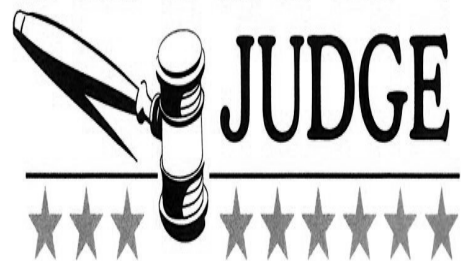

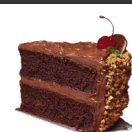
