### WORD HAS IT..... From Your Library

Book Review provided by Cathrin Peter, Club member: **'Tis: A Memoir by Frank McCourt**. This is the second in a series of three memoir books by the author: Book 1 *Angelea's Ashes*, Book 3 *Teacher Man: A Memoir*.

Review: "It is a great read. You don't know whether you want to hug him or knock him in the head. He has the heart of a poet, he is a miserable drunk or a sorry bitch. This is his life and he chose to live it this way. He caused a lot of misery to himself, but also to others. Yet he has his dignity and honor. Somehow, he manages to work through his early or lazy habits, but cannot live without his passion. If you are old enough, you understand and feel sorry for his predicament. If you are young and you read his life story, you might avoid some of the mishaps and pain in your own life. Regardless of how you react to his memoir, it is true to life and teaches the beauty of a life fully lived, ultimately connected to his Irish self, which inhabits his soul and won't leave him alone. I recommend this book to serious readers and lovers of life's mysteries."

Editor's Note: The author's first book, *Angelea's Ashes* can be found in the McNeeley Library. The book in this review, ***Tis***, and his third book, ***Teacher Man***, can be found in your local library at this time. All three books are memoirs of the author's life in Ireland and America. At the age of 19 he arrived in New York, later becomes a citizen of our country. He is drafted into the army, he returns to America in 1953, finding work on the docks. He continues his struggles to find his dream. He attended New York University, marries a Yankee lady. When he starts to teach and to write, he finds his place in our world.

Andrée Murphy is a leading Irish human rights advocate, writer, and commentator, known for her long-standing work on victims' rights, post-conflict justice, and constitutional change. Originally from Dublin and based in Belfast since 1994, she is a board member of Ireland's Future, the civic organization working to promote inclusive dialogue and preparation for potential constitutional change and a future referendum on Irish unity.

Murphy is the Deputy Director of Relatives for Justice, a Northern Ireland NGO that supports those bereaved or injured during the conflict. With two decades of experience, she specializes in trauma-informed advocacy, particularly supporting women affected by conflict. She holds an LLM in International Human Rights Law and Transitional Justice.

A prominent political commentator, she writes regularly for the Belfast Media Group and is a frequent contributor across radio and television. Her commentary focuses on legacy issues, policing, human rights, the Good Friday Agreement architecture, Brexit, and the political participation of women. She has represented victims and human rights interests before bodies including the United Nations Committee Against Torture in Geneva and U.S. congressional hearings.

Murphy is also a co-host of the Ireland's Future Podcast, where she engages with public figures, academics, and civic leaders about preparing for a united Ireland. Through her work with Ireland's Future, she has contributed significantly to international outreach, including to the Irish diaspora in the United States, emphasizing civic planning and inclusive dialogue as essential steps toward constitutional change.




