Forty years of festivals have been enjoyed by Clevelanders and many, many visitors. John became the twelfth president of the club in 1995. His first important task when he took office; the general meeting would start at 7 pm sharp. John will be missed in many ways by many people. Not the least by a long shot, he will be missed by the cats who call our club grounds their home because of his care.






