Patrick Lynch

For over a half a century, the name Pat Lynch was synonymous with the West Side Irish American Club and the Cleveland Irish community. A living legend in his own time. Most of his life was dedicated to the West Side Irish American Club. He was an officer in the Terrance MacSwiney Club and the Clan-Na-Gael, forerunners to the WSIA back in the early 1900's.

Pat Lynch was a co-founder of the WSIA and served as president for 34 years. He was the first to serve as president. To Pat Lynch, the success stories of the club were not contributed to any one individual, but to the many who labored diligently to swell its ranks, meet its emergencies, and fulfill its goals and aims.

Ireland, the land that gave him birth and the land he loved to visit, is now the place where he is buried. May he rest in peace.

For all of your love, kindness, and support following the passing of our Dad, we are deeply grateful. Your presence, friendship, heartfelt tributes, music, honor guard, food and the stories you shared brought comfort to our family and filled our hearts during a difficult time. 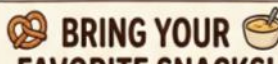
